Green Eggs and Ham Deviled Eggs

Servings: 24

12 large eggs
1/3 cup mayonnaise
1/4 cup chopped parsley
1/4 cup scallions
2 tablespoons capers
strips of deli-sliced ham (for garnish)

In a wide pot, place the eggs and cover with cold water by one inch. Bring to a boil. Reduce the heat to medium low and simmer for 10 minutes.

Drain the eggs and run under cold water to cool slightly. Peel and halve each egg lengthwise.

Scoop out the yolks and place in a large bowl. Mash the yolks.

Add the mayoonaise, parsley, scallions and capers. Puree' the mixture in a blender or food processor.

Spoon into the egg whites. Top with strips of ham.
