6 ounces cream cheese, room temperature 1 small onion, chopped 1 can (16 ounces) chili without beans 3/4 cup grated Monterey Jack cheese

Preheat the oven tio 325 degrees.

Cover the bottom of a one-quart casserole dish with a layer of the cream cheese. Sprinkle the onion on top.and spread a layer of chili over the onion. Top with a layer of the cheese.

Bake until bubbly, about 30 minutes.
